News from out and about

🌺 **World Cup is over!!** Sadly, we are not victors! But our team gave it their all and played some good games.

🌺 **Drunken Gulls found 'Smelling of Alcohol'.** The RSPCA have called for awareness to be raised about the dangers of leaving beer cans and bottles out with liquid still inside. The birds have been found with the symptoms of being unable to stand, staggering when trying to fly but symptoms seem to clear once they have vomited.

🌺 **200+ new Ambulances to be added to England Fleet.** The total is estimated to be 256 vehicles which will be funded by a government investment of £36.3m. More than half will become available for this coming winter. The funding will also be used to create hubs at ambulance trust headquarters to make vehicles ready for service.

🌺 **The Queen and Duke of Edinburgh to miss Christening!** The news that the Queen and the Duke will not be attending Prince Louis christening has been a surprise for many, but Buckingham Palace has said the decision was taken by the Queen and the Duke, along with the Duchess of Cambridge 'some time ago' and it is not due to health reasons. Prince Louis will be christened in a private ceremony in the Chapel Royal at St James's Palace. It will be the first time that the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge, and their 3 children will have been seen together.

News On this Date: July

1553:

On 9th July 1553 Lady Jane Gray was proclaimed Queen of England in succession to Edward 6th. She was Queen of England for just 9 days before the crown passed to Mary Tudor. It was hoped by some that Lady Jane Gray would prevent a Catholic rule, but Mary Tudors support was to great. Mary imprisoned Lady Jane Gray in the Tower of London and tried for high treason.

1877:

On 9th July 1877 the All England Croquet and Lawn Tennis Club opened its first tennis tournament in Wimbledon!

...and it is still going strong today!

1962:

On 10th July 1962 the Telstar, the world's first communication satellite, was launched. It successfully relayed through space the first television pictures, telephone calls and telegraph images and provided the first live transatlantic television feed.
